## **BACKGROUND**

In February 2017, a dedicated group of 31 community members, parents, Board of Education members, teachers, students, and administrators participated in Day 1 of our Strategic Plan workshop. Small groups were formed and rotated through different rooms with information on the Kansas Education Systems Accreditation (KESA), the 4 R's of KESA, and different examples of strategic plans. The groups came back together as a large group for a discussion on what they wanted in a strategic plan and its components.

Day 2 of the Strategic Plan workshop was held in March 2017. The groups divided into target areas that were selected at the last Strategic Plan Day 1 workshop. The groups developed possible action steps, timeline, responsibilities, and evaluation. The draft documents that were completed in these groups and were then reviewed by a group of administrators who made corrections and put everything together into a Strategic Plan final draft. This draft was presented to the Board for review at the May 2017 Board of Education meeting, with final approval in July 2017.

## **KANSAS VISION FOR EDUCATION**

Kansans are demanding higher standards in academic skills, as well as employability and citizenship skills, and the need to move away from a “one-size-fits-all” system that relies exclusively on state assessments. This new vision for education calls for a more student-focused system that provides support and resources for individual success and will require everyone to work together to make it a reality. ## **DEFINING SUCCESS**

A successful Kansas high school graduate has the academic preparation, cognitive preparation, technical skills, employability skills and civic engagement to be successful in postsecondary education, in the attainment of an industry recognized certification or in the workforce, without the need for remediation.

### **KANSAS EDUCATION SYSTEMS ACCREDITATION (KESA)**

The Kansas Education Systems Accreditation (KESA) is the new model for accreditation for our Kansas school districts. Supporting this model is the rich research base of systems theory, which resoundingly shows that sustained improvement of a system requires viewing the system as a whole—analyzing each part’s impact on the system. Any change to one part of the system affects (positively or negatively) other parts of the system and, therefore, the system as a whole. Kansas’s proposed new accreditation model uses the 21st Century themes of Relationships, Relevance, Responsive Culture, Results and Rigor (“The Five Rs”) as a framework within which to focus on the quality characteristics of an educational system.

### **GATHERING INPUT**

As part of the new KESA model, Kansas Vision for Education, and the Strategic Plan development, Tonganoxie USD 464 also sought input from its staff. All staff members were given surveys during the 2016-17 school year representing the 4 R’s. The surveys revealed the district’s strengths and weaknesses, and we were able to glean valuable information and select 2 R’s for our goals:

- Relevance
- Relationships

The survey data determined that there were several areas of focus in the Relevance and Relationships rubrics that would promote growth and improvement in Tonganoxie USD 464. We will focus on the Relevance and Relationships goals for this accreditation cycle. A third R, Results, is required for all school districts, so we will focus on the three R’s.

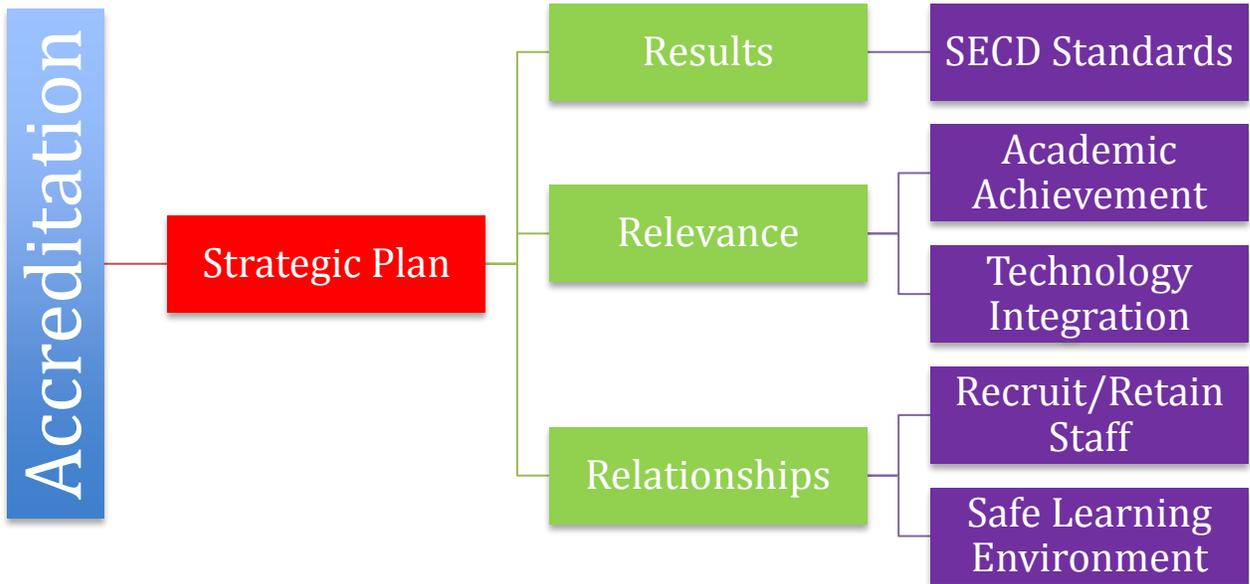
- Has a shared vision, clear goals, and a commitment to continuous improvement.
