



## On-Site Learning Safety Protocols At-a-Glance



- Students and staff will have a daily temperature check upon entering the building
- Anyone having a temperature of 100.4 or greater or showing COVID symptoms will be sent home



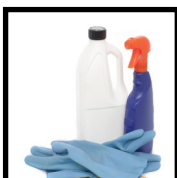
- All students and staff are required to wear a mask to and during school, with exemptions as stated under Governor Kelly's [Executive Order 20-59](#).
- Alternative face shields will be utilized when required for the learning environment



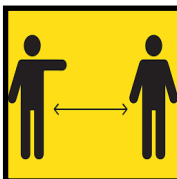
- Classroom safeguards will be established for movement and grouping
- Materials will not be shared without proper sanitizing
- Classroom seating will be spaced as allowed, placed in rows, facing forward
- Plexiglas dividers will be utilized when appropriate for extra protection



- All classrooms, hallways, cafeterias, and entryways will have hand sanitizer available
- Students and staff will be required to wash or sanitize their hands every hour
- Hands will be sanitized upon entry into the building



- Intensified cleaning and disinfection of high touch surfaces, supplies, and areas will take place during school and after hours
- Foggers will be used in the buildings as necessary
- Staff will routinely disinfect high touch areas in the classrooms



- While schools and classrooms were not designed to physically distance our students and staff, new procedures and protocols will be used to maximize social distancing when reasonable
- In cases where social distancing is not possible, we will use modified practices to limit close contact as much as possible



- All students and staff are required to wear a mask to and during school, with exemptions as stated under Governor Kelly's [Executive Order 20-59](#).
- Seats will be assigned
- When possible, students will board from the back to front to limit exposure
- Buses will be sanitized after each route



- Visitor access will be limited to essential services and business needs
- Any essential visitor will have temperature screened and must wear a mask
- Visitors and parents/guardians are asked to wait in the office or outside when picking up a student
